



## WYO PERFORMING ARTS & EDUCATION CENTER

Phased approach to increasing capacity  
(supplementing WYO's reopening plan updated January 2021)

### **Beginning March 16**

- Capacity for WYO events will remain at 25% or 120 attendees
- Patrons will be strongly encouraged to wear masks in common areas
- Staff and volunteers will be required to wear masks during events
- All other guidelines outlined in the WYO's reopening plan will be adhered to including pre-screening volunteers and opening the house 45 minutes prior to the event to quickly seat people

### **3 Weeks of Sheridan County remaining stable, at 10 or below new Covid Cases**

- Capacity for WYO events can increase to 31% or 150 attendees (this increases seating on the main floor only – not balconies)
- Masking requirements will be reviewed and announced based on CDC guidance
- Volunteers will no longer be pre-screened but encouraged to stay home should they show Covid Symptoms or been exposed to someone with Covid (even if they've had their vaccine)
- House and lobby shall open at the same time however Patrons should start utilizing paper tickets
- Glasses of wine may be sold in the concessions area
- Crossover between front of house and back of house will continue to be discouraged

### **3 Weeks of Sheridan County remaining stable at 5 or below new Covid Cases**

- Capacity for WYO events can increase to 45% or 219 attendees
- Masks will no longer be required or encouraged (based on CDC guidelines)
- House and lobby may open at separate times ie. one hour vs 30 minutes
- Crossover between front of house and back of house will be reviewed and announced based on CDC guidance

### **3 Weeks of Sheridan County remaining stable at 2 or 0 new Covid Cases**

- Capacity for WYO events can increase to 100%
- All Covid guidelines (except for cleaning protocols)

**Any increase in capacity will first be based on local evidence as well as CDC guidelines and will be re-evaluated and adjusted as necessary.**
