***TIPS:** The City of Sheridan requires anyone who is serving alcohol to be TIPS (Training for Intervention Procedures) trained. If you would like to serve your own beer you must have completed this training in the last 3 years and be able to produce your certificate. If you are not certified please contact Erin Butler (info below) to discuss training options.

ENTRY: All contestants must be at least 21 years of age. There is no entry fee. Submit entry form and fee to the WYO Theater, P.O. Box 528, Sheridan, WY 82801 no later than Friday June 24th. Please provide as close to 5 gallons per entry as possible.

BREWERS CHOICE: The homebrew fest will feature each contestant's beer sampled by local judges in a blind taste test. The winner of this vote will receive a cash prize along with other special prizes yet to be announced.

POPULAR VOTE: The homebrew fest will feature each contestant's beer sampled by attendees. Each attendee will receive a token to cast their vote for their favorite beer. A cash prize will be awarded to the winner of the popular vote.

SERVING & TENT SET UP: Contestants are responsible for their own tent and display. Booth size is limited to a 10x10 space and booth placement is at the discretion of the event organizers. Contestants should have the name of beer, and beer style on display. Additional information such as ABV, IBU or color is recommended. Please see attached list for other necessary and suggested items. Homebrewers can begin set up by 11:00am and should be ready by 11:45am.

Trained pets on a leash are welcome. Festival organizers reserve the right to ask owners of dangerous or unruly pets to leave.
